2007 BARBERA

PAULI RANCH, UKIAH VALLEY,
MENDOCINO COUNTY

VINEYARD

Our Barbera is from the Pauli ranch, a vineyard planted by the Mondavi's just north of Ukiah on the Valley Floor. This benchland vineyard lies in an old river bed with gravely soil, which helps to produce a full flavored Barbera.

VINTAGE

The 2007 vintage was of great quality with less quantity. Flavors were intense. An ideal growing season producing smaller clusters.

WINEMAKING

The grapes were handpicked late in the season on October 11, then rushed to the winery. Cold soaked for three days, then fermented in open top tanks and punched down twice a day. Barrel aged for twelve months in 30% new French and Hungarian oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Enjoy the aromas of plum and black pepper with cherry liquor. Savor the bright fruit and velvety texture with a burst of cherries and a lingering finish.
