VINEYARD

HARVEST DATE October 30th, 2011 Our Barbera is from the Pauli ranch, a vineyard planted by the Mondavi's just north of Ukiah on the Valley Floor. This benchland vineyard lies in an old river bed with gravely soil, which helps to produce a full flavored Barbera.

BOTTLED September 15, 2012

VINTAGE

pH 3.56 The 2011 vintage was of great quality with less quantity. Flavors were intense. An ideal growing season producing smaller clusters.

ALCOHOL

WINEMAKING

14.2%

The grapes were handpicked late in the season on October 30, then rushed to the winery. Cold soaked for three days, then fermented in open top tanks and punched down twice a day. Barrel aged for twelve months in 30% new French and Hungarian oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

This complex wine has intriguing aromas of high-tone red fruits, wild herbs, espresso and new tobacco. On the palate, it shows expressive flavors of ripe raspberry, cherry, plum, orange rind and savory spices. This wine has nice rounded tannins, vibrant acidity and a dry finish. It is a New World version of an admirable grape varietal, originally made famous in the Piedmont region of Italy.
