UNTI VINEYARDS

DRY CREEK VALLEY, SONOMA COUNTY

VINEYARD

Unti Vineyard lies in the heart of the Dry Creek Valley. The fruit comes from the creekside block, perfect for growing a big, fruit forward Syrah. These grapes were also bio-dynamically grown.

VINTAGE

The 2011 vintage was of great quality and less quantity. Flavors were intense. An ideal growing season with smaller clusters.

WINEMAKING

The grapes were picked at dawn and cold soaked for four days, then fermented in open top tanks and punched down twice a day. The wine was aged for twelve months in 30% new French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Complex aromas of dark fruit, blood orange peel, clove, leather and hickory smoke. Concentrated flavors of dark cherry, dried cranberry, blueberry and roasted fig dusted with cinnamon. A magnificent integration of deep flavors, vibrant acidity and hints of oak with a long, dry finish.
